And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb.

Luke 24:2

This begins Luke's account of the most important day in the history of the world. The Resurrection of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. The week prior had been a wide range of emotion to say the least. The triumph and glory entering Jerusalem would turn to betrayal, denial, unspeakable physical and psychological pain, anguish, fear and despair. Now, at the tomb, confusion, which will quickly turn to joy, celebration, love and ever-growing faith like never before.

When I think of Easter Sundays, I think of congregations wearing their "Easter best". I think of pastel colors, flowers in bloom, family gatherings and chorus of voices greeting each other with "He is risen" to the response of "He is risen indeed!" 


