## From the Pastor's Desk:

The Good Samaritan Fund that was funded and used by several of the local West Jefferson churches is now no longer operational. In that absence, Council has decided that we do not wish to turn people away who have basic needs for gasoline for their cars, bus fare home, money to avoid their utilities being cut off or food.

To that end, we will be funding our own fund so that we do not need to turn people away who come to Zion's doors. That said, I do keep limited hours here as I am 50% time - so I don't anticipate a huge wellspring of activity, but if the past is any indicator - we usually have several people each month coming to Zion with needs.

We do not yet have a name for this new fund. Suggestions have been: Zion's Purse, Zion's Samaritan Fund, and Zion's Community Fund. If you have a name to suggest or if you really like one of these, please let me know! We will be determining the name at our council meeting in August. For now - if you wish to give to the account - simply note - 'Samaritan Fund' on your envelope and it will go toward helping those in our community through Zion.


