From the Pastor's Desk:

As you may be aware, our air conditioner unit in the sanctuary is barely limping along. Council has gotten several bids to determine the cost of replacing the system. This event has caused us as a council to consider again what is the most faithful way forward in the midst of this very large expense (approximately \$10,000). We do have money in our mutual funds to cover this cost, but this may or may not be the best use of those funds.

Some ideas that we have considered are that we sell the property and rent space in a store front, local school or church instead and have services there, or that we continue where we are and use the money to fix the air conditioner, or that we continue to work toward merging with another church (although that scenario seems unlikely), or work toward closing our ministry here. Our President will be sending out a letter sometime in September or early October to explain more fully the situation and options that we see before us. Council plans to have a town meeting several weeks prior to our annual congregational meeting that is always held in November where we can talk faithfully and frankly about our options before we call for a vote on this matter at our November Congregational meeting.

We look forward to your prayers and your feedback regarding what the future ministry of Zion looks like. Let us not be afraid but faithful!

WELCA Meeting


The next WELCA general meeting is scheduled for Sept 18 at 6:00 pm.
