In just a couple of months, we will be celebrating the 500th anniversary of Martin Luther's nailing of his 95 theses to the doors of Wittenberg, leading to the birth of the Lutheran Church and many other Protestant churches. Martin Luther was passionate about redemption. Agonizing over his own perceived inadequacies, he obsessively tried to earn this redemption by exercising all of the rites and rituals then prescribed by the church to appease what he thought was an angry God. This obsessive passion led him to go to lengths beyond just accepting the current teachings of the Church, and reach into the Scriptures themselves for answers. It was there, in the Scriptures, that God's Grace was revealed to him.

How was it that such a marvelous concept as Grace could have been lost by such learned scholars as those occupying the leadership of the church? It was the GOSPEL that they forgot about! How could that have happened? The answer, of course, is in the very reason God's Grace is needed in the first place. The church was headed by humans and humans are deeply flawed. Luther's rediscovery of God's Grace re-lit the light of hope in a dark world.

Every Sunday, we repeat a confession that reminds us of the fact that, "All have sinned and come short of the glory of God". But, at the end of the service, in the meal of Christ's Body and Blood, we are celebrating our Justification before God, by Grace, through faith. Let us never find
